Some Rules of Moncton Games:

1. Competitors must report to the Steward's tent on arrival, for playing time; failure to report in time may result in disqualification.
2. Competitions are under rules and regulations of the Atlantic Canada Pipe Band Association.
3. Failure to show up at event location, on time, may result in disqualification.
4. Individuals exceeding the ACPBA tuning time may be disqualified.
5. Competitors will be prevented from competing or receiving awards if not wearing proper highland dress as described in the ACPBA Rules and Regulations.
6. Playing order will be first registered, last to play.
7. No entry fees will be refunded unless event is cancelled.
8. Band tents may be available.
9. Sponsors will not be responsible for loss, damage, or injury at the games.
