## 2010 Atlantic Canada Piobaireachd Challenge

For the first time since this competition's inception in 1990, competitors may submit the tune(s) of their own choice.

If settings used are taken from sources other than the Kilberry or Piobaireachd Society collections, competitors must be prepared to provide the judge with a copy of the tune in the setting to be played. The judge may take into consideration the merits of the setting played.

### Submission Requirements:

**Gold Medal** – four (4) tunes; **Silver Medal** – three (3) tunes; **Nickel Medal** - two (2) tunes; **Bronze Medal** - one (1) tune (Note: crunluath a mach variation is not required at the Bronze Medal level. If played, however, it shall be judged); **Copper Medal** – one (1) tune (Note: crunluath a mach is not required at the Copper Medal level. If played, however, it shall be judged); **Pewter Medal** – Ground and 1<sup>st</sup> Variation Singling only of one (1) tune.

In events where more than one tune is to be submitted, the judge will select the tune to be played and competitors will be notified prior to their playing time.

### Restrictions:

**Gold Medal** event - Professional Class pipers only; **Silver Medal** event – Grade 1 pipers only; **Nickel Medal** event – Grade 2 pipers only; **Bronze Medal** event - Grades 3 pipers only; **Copper Medal** event – Grade 4 pipers only; **Pewter Medal** event - Grade 5 pipers only. Competitors from Atlantic Canada must be current members of the ACPBA. Competitors from other jurisdictions must be members of their own regional associations. In all events, tuning time before the judge must be kept to a minimum.

**Order of Play:** Last to enter in each event plays first. Competitors are asked to present themselves to the judge within three minutes of the completion of the previous competitor's performance. The order of play will be posted.

**Entry Fee:** All entries must be accompanied by a cheque or money order in the amount of \$10.00 made payable to **The Antigonish Highland Society**.

**Deadline for entries:** Friday, May 28th. Absolutely no late entries and no telephone entries accepted.
