This is the 60th anniversary of the Gathering of the Clans. The event started in 1951 to raise funds to build a hospital. Sixty years later, the Village of Pugwash is again looking at building a new medical facility and as a community we need to help raise funds to do this.

Competitors, judges and stewards are not required to purchase an entrance fee. Everyone else should be sure to purchase their entrance bracelet at the ticket gates. Adults \$5, for children 5 to 12 the fee is \$3, children under 5 can enter FREE! We appreciate your support and cooperation in our drive to fund our new medical facility!

The Gathering of the Clans organizers recognise that there are fewer bands competing every year and meanwhile travelling costs keep going up! For the first time this year, as a special BONUS to competing band organizations, there will be an ADDITIONAL \$1000 awarded that organization to help defray their costs a little more!

We hope that you enjoy your stay in this beautiful little Village. Stay all day and take in the other events of the day which include Highland dancing in Eaton Park, heavyweight Highland games, Midway, artisan and food street vendors, dog agility show, live music all afternoon and evening with fabulous fireworks at 10pm.

Early arrivals can enjoy a sausage and pancake breakfast for \$6 at the brand new Pugwash fire station just east of the Village limits at 11057 Route 6 from 7am to 9am.

DIRECTIONS TO PUGWASH – from points east

- Coming from the east on the Trans Canada Highway HWY 104, take exit 11 at Glenholme and left onto Route 4 towards Folly Lake and Wentworth.
- After about 30km, in Wentworth, turn right onto Highway 307 towards Wallace and Pugwash.
- After 8.5km turn left towards Pugwash onto the Fountain Road, a short winding road which takes you to Howard's Bridge over Wallace River (single lane bridge) and then to Highway 368.
- At Hwy 368 turn right (north) towards Route 6 (Wallace and Pugwash) - 7km.
- At Route 6 (Sunrise Trail) turn left (west) towards Pugwash - 7km

#### **DIRECTIONS TO PUGWASH – from points west**

- Coming from the west on the Trans Canada Highway HWY 104, at Amherst take exit 3 towards Route 6 (Sunrise Trail) toward Victoria Street
- Follow the Sunrise Trail east to Pugwash ~60km
- In Pugwash Village, Route 6 (Sunrise Trail) is called Durham Street

- From Durham Street, turn north onto Church Street.

- Security personnel will direct you from there.
- Competing and Parade bands muster on the Cyrus Eaton Elementary School playgrounds.
- The Competitions are held at National historic site, Thinkers' Lodge, at the north end of Water Street
- Water Street will be blocked off to traffic but there is ample parking throughout the Village.
- Please be aware of areas blocked off for disabled parking.
- There will be ample receptacles for garbage and recycling throughout the Village.
- Washrooms are available at the Village Hall and there are portaloos throughout the Village for the event.
