Rules for Piping, Drumming and Pipe Band Events

- (1) All events will be run in accordance with the Atlantic Canada Pipe Band Association (ACPBA) rules and regulations
- (2) Runners will not be provided.
- (3) Band order of play will be drawn daily at 11:00 A.M.
- (4) **No refund** of entries submitted.
- (5) Playing times will be posted on order of play board located directly behind The College
- (6) Bands must form up by 12:30 P.M. Saturday for 1st massed band.
- (7) First prize in the Open Piobaireachd will only be awarded if performance is deserving.
- (8) There must be more than one entry in an event in order for the competition to take place.
- (9) Competitors shall abide by the code of conduct (section 10 ACPBA rules as it refers to proper dress and behaviour, or risk not receiving their prize.
- (10) Drum Fanfare must have a minimum of three members and a minimum 3 to 5 minutes duration.

Rules and regulations:

- Only the first 8 entries will be accepted
- Must submit the names of performers for entry to be accepted, and notify organizer of any subsequent changes
- Maximum number of performers: 8
- Minimum number of performers: 4
- Must have at least one piper and one drummer. The rest is wide open...
- No person may perform with more than one Mini Band
- Each performance should be roughly 5 minutes long – anything much longer will get “the hook”
- Will be judged by 3 “secret adjudicators” – will be judged on entertainment value provided
- Entry fee is \$15 per Mini Band – fee is *not* required until notification that entry has been successfully received among the first 8 entries
- Winner receives the sum of all entry fees (maximum of \$120)
